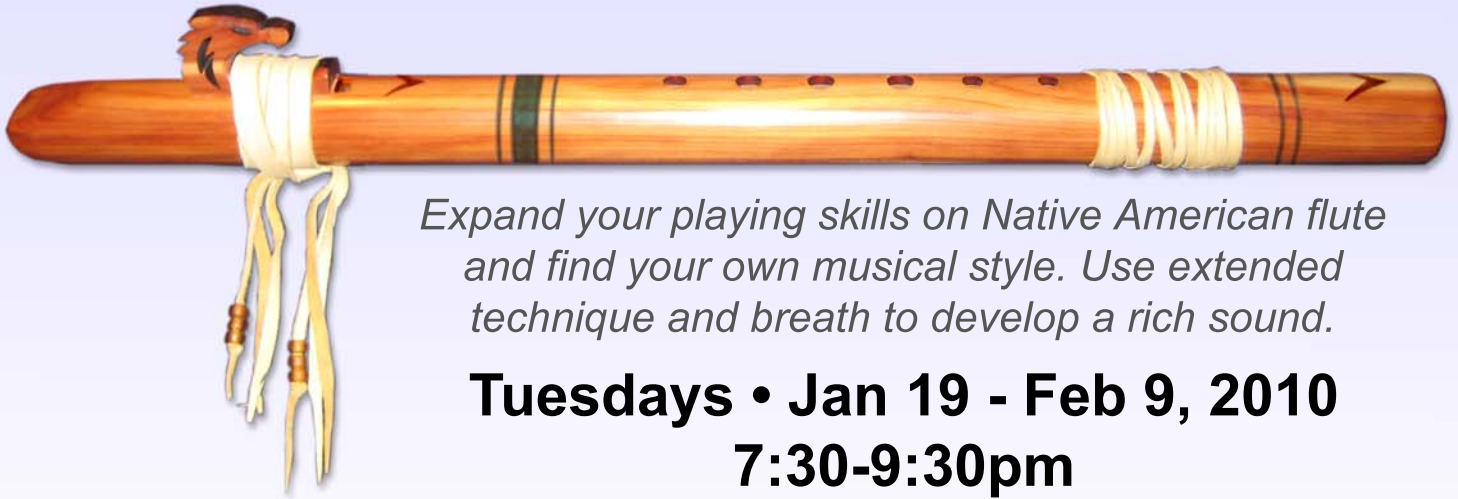


# Learn the Native American Flute
